Our call volumes continue to remain high, especially calls for our ambulance which continues to be maintained and stocked with essential supplies thanks to your ongoing contributions. We have seen an increase in new members and as always, we welcome new members as we have many jobs to be done and have a role to match anyone's level of interest and expertise.

In this edition we announce the arrival of Bemus Point's new fire engine which brings the latest safety features to our firefighters. Staying current with safety takes the form of replacing worn equipment, providing classroom training opportunities, and in some cases, satisfying unfunded government mandates for equipment and training. Your support is essential to allow us to stay current.

As we look ahead to 2015, we see continued challenges across volunteer fire and emergency services in recruiting new members, especially in providing emergency medical services. If you or someone you know has an interest in providing life-saving services to your community, whether it is Bemus Point, or elsewhere, we encourage you learn more. Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) classes are offered twice a year, at no cost to the student. For college students, local tuition grants are available to students who volunteer during their studies – visit the fire department to learn more about how being a volunteer can help cover college tuition costs.

We welcome you to visit the fire hall any Tuesday evening to see our equipment and meet our members who represent a diverse cross section of our community from high school and college students to retirees, local business owners and seasonal residents, and backgrounds as varied as the people themselves. 


NEW FIRE ENGINE IN SERVICE



After 20 years of service to the community, Bemus Point's old Pierce Lance fire engine, which faced structural wear and tear and rising repair expenses, has been retired and replaced with a 2015 Pierce Impel fire engine. This new apparatus contains the latest in safety features for our firefighters, most notably an enclosed crew compartment which protects our volunteers in transit and provides a place of shelter from the heat of summer or a call on an icy night in winter. The engine is able to carry a crew of six firefighters and brings new features not seen in Bemus, such as an

innovative lighting tower which can provide incredible scene lighting capabilities, increasing safety in nighttime operations. We look forward to decades of service from our new "Engine 442" and welcome you to visit the fire hall on a Tuesday evening to see it for yourself.

FIRE SAFETY EDUCATION



This year we continued our focus on fire prevention through three of our favorite activities: Fire Prevention Night at the Bemus Point Library, Toddler Reading Hour at the fire hall, and our annual visit to the fire hall from more than 200 students from the Bemus Point Elementary School. During our Fire Prevention Night last Spring we discussed kitchen safety tips, including never leaving items cooking unattended on a stovetop, and extinguishing a grease fire on a stove by placing a lid on the pan - not using water. Our school visitors learned about smoke alarms, and had a chance to see our firefighters in their full protective gear, and had an opportunity to climb aboard our new fire engine! Your contributions allow us to send our visitors home with kid-sized fire helmets and safety education materials.

This year's national Fire Prevention Week theme was "Working Smoke Alarms Save Lives". Have you changed the batteries and tested the smoke alarms in your home?
