Dear Patron Fire Fighter,

As we near the end of 2015, and look forward to time with family and friends during the holidays, we reflect on another very busy year at the Bemus Point Volunteer Fire Department. Our call volumes for the year are approaching all-time highs, led by calls for our ambulance, stocked with essential supplies to provide advanced life support, thanks to your ongoing contributions. We have been fortunate to have some new members join us this year and as always, we welcome new members as we have many jobs to be done and have a role to match anyone's level of interest and expertise.

Our members continued to build skill through attending NY State Fire classes locally and at the NY State Fire Academy in Montour Falls, NY. Volunteers attended classes in firefighting, fire engine pump operations, and a variety of emergency medicine and rescue operations. Our volunteers participated in county-wide emergency drills, including the annual Ice Rescue Drill, where our ice-rescue airboat played a role, and our Boston Whaler rescue boat provided critical assistance on the lake last summer. We

appreciate your ongoing support to maintain our equipment and supplies.

As we look ahead to 2016, we see continued challenges across volunteer fire and emergency services in recruiting new members, especially in providing emergency medical services. If you or someone you know has an interest in providing life-saving services to your community, whether it is Bemus Point, or elsewhere, we encourage you learn more. Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) classes are offered twice a year, at no cost to the student. For college students, local tuition grants are available to students who volunteer during their studies - visit the fire department to learn more about how being a volunteer can help cover college tuition costs.

We welcome you to visit the fire hall any Tuesday evening to see our equipment and meet our members who represent a diverse cross section of our community from high school and college students to retirees, local business owners and seasonal residents, and backgrounds as varied as the people themselves. Our doors are open every Tuesday evening, and we welcome you and your family to stop in and see your local

Some, like this year's recipient, support the aforementioned by controlling traffic, retrieving tools or hoses, or providing cooling rags and bottled water among other critical duties. Louise Parker, a vital part of our Fire Police team, exemplifies the ideals of this honor.

Louise, a Bemus Point native, joined the Department in 2011 when her son, Assistant Chief, and last year's recipient, Randy Edwards mentioned that he thought she would make a good Fire Police Member. After joining, Louise took the Scene Support Class, became involved in all the departmental events, and then in 2012 won the office of Treasurer. SANTA VISITS THE BEMUS POINT FIRE HALL


